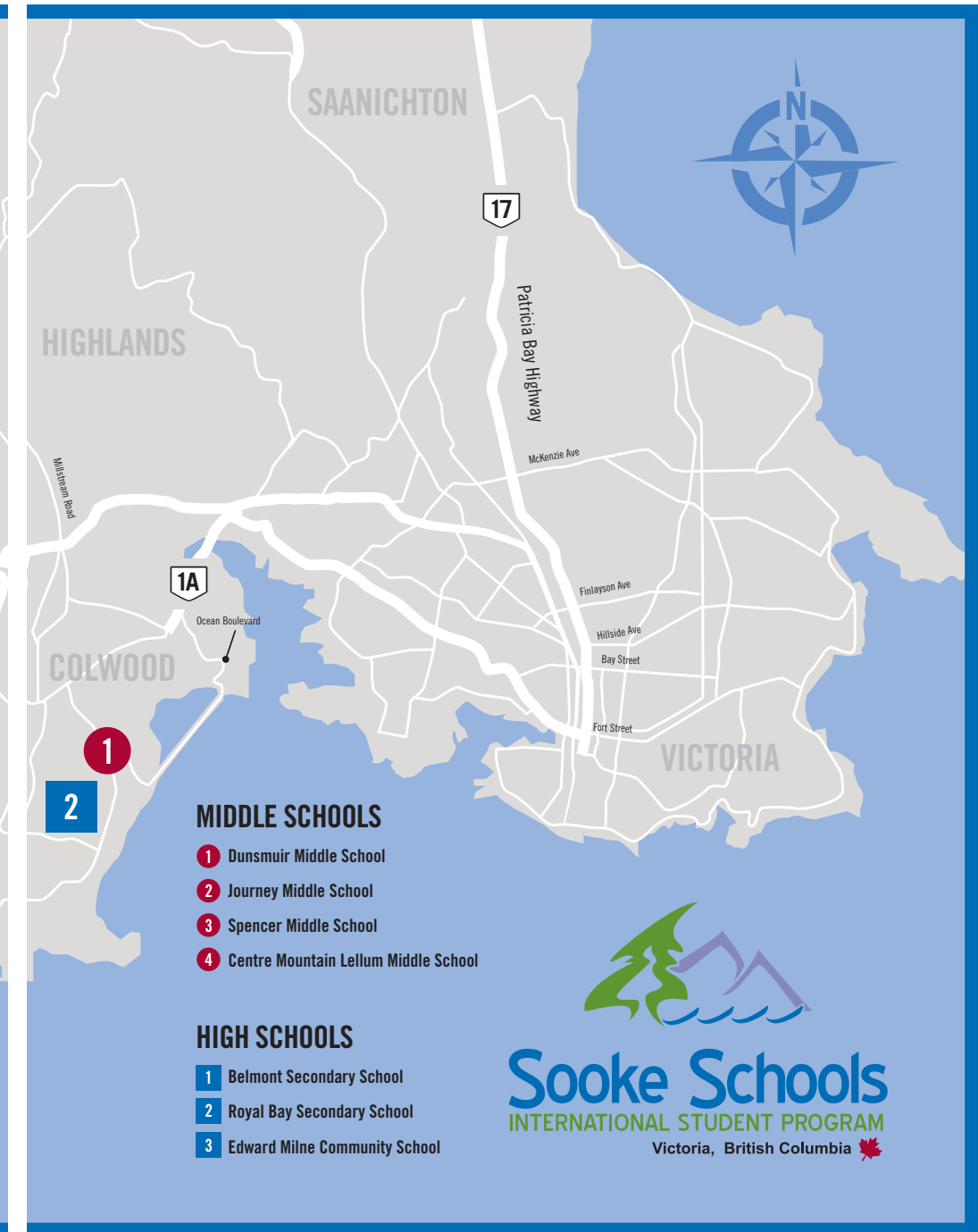
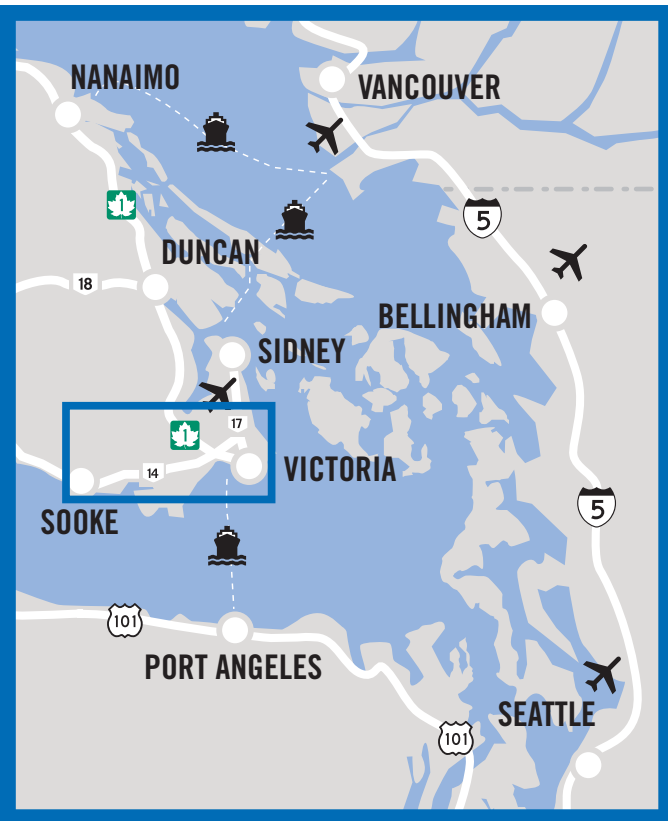

International students who study in our schools come for many different goals and purposes, and we offer a variety of program types to meet their needs.

SCHOOLS

The Sooke School District is home to 3 secondary schools and 4 middle schools that welcome international students. Two of our high schools were recently built, having opened their doors in September of 2015.

Our high schools are on a semester (half-year) system. Each semester lasts for five months (September – January and February – June), and students generally study four courses per semester. All of our schools follow the curriculum and learning standards set by the British Columbia Ministry of Education, taught by B.C.-certified teachers. The standard of education is commonly recognized as one of the highest in the world. Sooke Schools offer students a variety of academic and elective courses to meet their individual needs and interests. Students interested in an academically rigorous program have the opportunity to choose from Advanced Placement (AP) courses, as well as dual-credit university level courses offered right at their high school.

Our students always enjoy the opportunity to take elective courses in subject areas such as woodworking, foods and nutrition, film and television studies, marketing, psychology, and environmental studies, among others.

Many of our schools offer specialized Academy Programs, where students can focus on developing their athletic skills during the school day. Academies offered at our schools are: Equine Academy, Baseball Academy, Rugby Academy, Soccer Academy, Dance Academy, Lacrosse Academy and Ice Hockey Academy.



ACADEMIC GRADUATION PROGRAM

Students who wish to graduate from one of our high schools with a B.C. Dogwood Diploma can apply to our Academic Graduation Program. Students typically need at least two years to successfully complete the graduation requirements, and may take longer. A demonstration of strong English preparation is needed at the time of application.

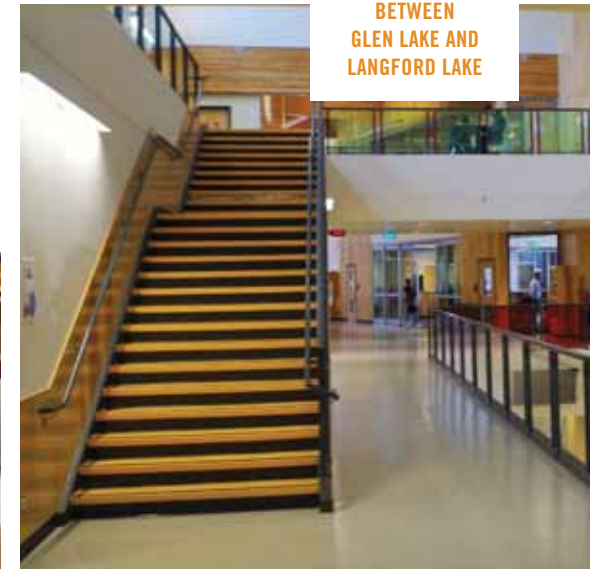
Centrally located in Langford, Belmont is the school district's most urban secondary school.

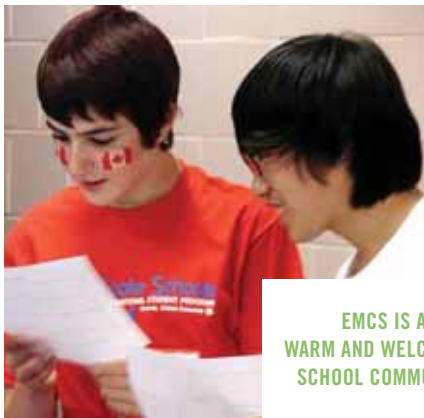

HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION

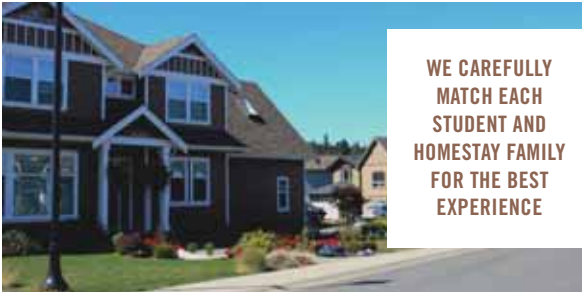

- ... and much more!



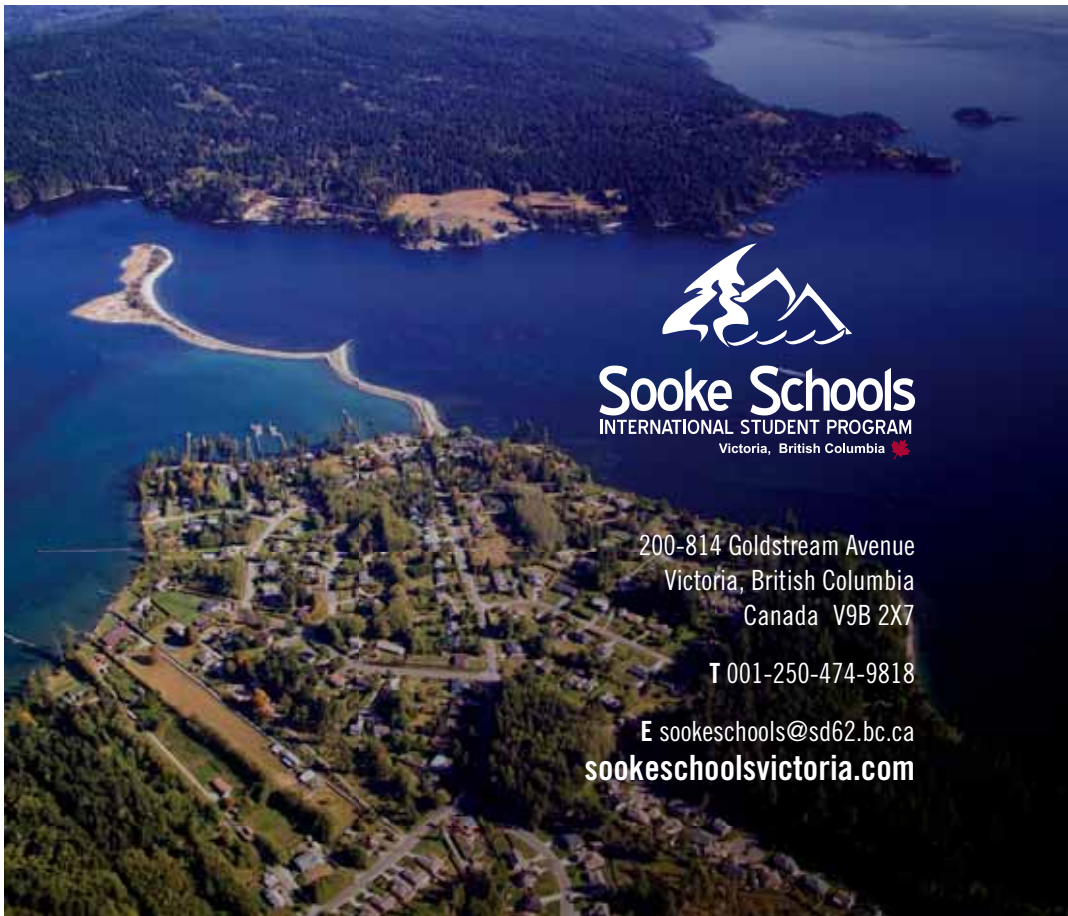
